The 366ft vessel Chaudiere is a Restigouche class Destroyer Escort built in Halifax in 1953. In 1992 HMCS Chaudiere was the first destroyer-escort to be sunk to form an artificial reef. It is located in Sechart Inlet off Kunichin Point and it is only accessible by boat. A section of the bow was removed and installed on HMCS Kootenay after a collision.

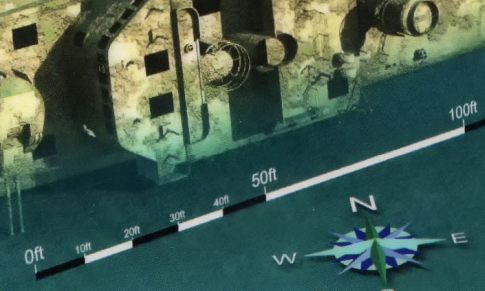
